* **QUEEN'S HOUSE RETREAT & RENEWAL CENTRE** – Effective March 18, 2020 Queen's House Retreat and Renewal Centre is temporarily closed to the public due to the COVID-19 virus and will remain closed at minimum until April 30, 2020. In October 2019 the Ukrainian Catholic Foundation called for applications for the Ukrainian Catholic Foundation Grant Fund Program. This Grant Fund was established when the Sheptytsky Institute building was sold, and the proceeds of sale were used to establish the Ukrainian Catholic Foundation Grant Fund Program. Investment Income earned on this fund is distributed to Parishes/Missions or Eparchial Organizations for various initiatives to assist them in becoming “Vibrant Parishes/Missions/Organizations” within the Eparchy.
