UPDATED INSTRUCTIONS FOR ATTENDING DIVINE LITURGY AT SAINTS PETER & PAUL

- ***Sunday Divine Liturgies will begin on the weekend of Saturday, June 27 and Sunday, June 28.*** Sunday Liturgies will be on Saturday evening at 5:00 p.m. and Sunday mornings at 9:00 a.m. (Ukrainian with English readings and homily) and 11:00 a.m.
- **Those wishing to attend Divine Liturgy on SUNDAYS and MAJOR FEAST DAYS must make a reservation and receive confirmation to attend.** To do this contact the parish office either by phone (306-343-6516) during office hours or email (sspp@sasktel.net). Only when you receive a confirmation of your request can you then attend Liturgy. **No walk-ins are allowed.**
- On major feast days, we have Liturgies at 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Upcoming major feast Days Saints Peter & Paul on June 29 and Transfiguration on August 6. On civic holidays like Canada Day, Divine Liturgy is 9:00 a.m.
- Liturgies are at 8:00 a.m. from Monday to Friday. Saturday morning Divine Liturgy is at 9:00 a.m. **You no longer have to pre-register with the parish office for Liturgies on Monday to Saturday morning. Please register when you get to church.** This is necessary in case contact tracing is required.
- Please do not arrive more than 15 minutes before the Liturgy is scheduled to begin.
- **MASKS - Children under the age of 8 are not required to wear a mask. Children aged 8 and over should wear a mask if they are able. All adults are required to wear a mask during the entire service.** Masks will not be provided so it is necessary to bring your own. Please put your mask on in your car or in the vestibule. If you are not able to wear a mask then we ask that you do not attend Liturgy.
- Liturgy books are available at the back of the church to borrow and take home after.
- Please sit only at the places with a cross made out of tape on the pew backrest. Sit together with members of your own household only.
- Please do not move around the church. Remain at your seat for the entire service except if you have to use the washroom.
- Instructions will be given as to how to receive Eucharist during the liturgy. Eucharist will be with only bread and no wine. Eucharist will be given at the end of Liturgy. Please practice physical distancing in the communion line.
- At the end of Liturgy, please lower the kneeler, because this helps to indicate where sanitization is required after the Liturgy.
- Those who are medically vulnerable and at high risk should consider not attending Divine Liturgy at this time. Liturgies on Sundays and major feast days will continue to be posted on YouTube. The obligation to attend Liturgy on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is still dispensed by Bishop Bryan.

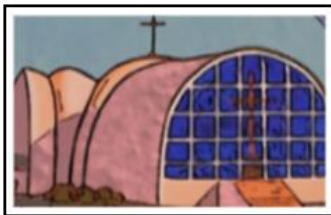

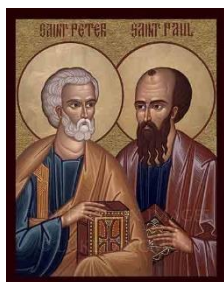

Parishioners have been asking how they can donate financially to the church during this time of the COVID-19 pandemic, even when we are slowly reopening. We offer different means to allow you to donate financially to the parish.

We offer different means to allow you to donate financially to the parish at this time if you are able.

1. Set up pre-authorized debit (PAD) for monthly donations. [Click here for the PAD form.](#)
 - You can print the form off, complete it, sign it, and mail it in with a void cheque.
 - You can also drop off your completed and signed form with a void cheque in the **NEW** secure parish mail slot in the blue door on the north side of the rectory by the Fathers' garages.
 - You can also complete the form, sign it, scan it, and submit the form over email to sspp@sasktel.net (please submit an electronic void cheque from your bank with the form).
2. **NEW!** Make an E-TRANSFER one-time donation.
 - Make a donation directly from your bank account using your online banking or your banking app on your smartphone.
 - Use the parish email, sspp@sasktel.net, as the recipient.
 - We are set up for auto deposit so no passwords or secret questions are required.
 - Call or email Theresa in the parish office if you need more information or help.
3. **NEW!** Make a one-time donation on your CREDIT CARD through the Ukrainian Catholic Foundation of Saskatchewan website.
 - Go to the [Foundation website](#). Use the **YELLOW** button.
 - Direct your online donation to "Saints Peter & Paul, Saskatoon" in the comments section. The Foundation will gather these designated donations and on a monthly basis send them to our parish.
4. **We continue to accept donations at the rectory.**
 - Simply drop your donation in the **NEW** secure parish mail slot in the blue door on the north side of the rectory by the Fathers' garages.
 - You can also send cheques (no cash) in the mail.
 - We encourage you to continue to make your donation by the methods above, but there will be a basket at Divine Liturgies at the front of the church where you can drop your donation envelope.

As with your regular donations (numbered envelopes), pre-authorized debit, e-transfers, and credit card donations through the foundation are tax deductible.
