UPDATED INSTRUCTIONS FOR ATTENDING DIVINE LITURGY AT SAINTS PETER & PAUL

- **Sunday Liturgies** are at the following times: **Saturday 5:00 p.m., Sunday 9:00 a.m. (Ukrainian) & Sunday 11:00 a.m.** Those wishing to attend Divine Liturgy on Saturday evenings and Sunday mornings must make a reservation and receive confirmation to attend. To do this contact the parish office either by phone (306-343-6516) during office hours or email (sspp@sasktel.net) by Friday at 4:00 p.m. Only when you receive a confirmation of your request can you then attend Liturgy. **No walk-ins are allowed.**
- **You do not need to pre-register for Liturgies on Feast Days, weekdays, Saturday mornings, or civic holidays.** Please register at the door when you get to church for any of these Liturgies. This is necessary in case contact tracing is required.
- On major feast days, we have Liturgies at 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Liturgies are at 8:00 a.m. from Monday to Friday. Saturday morning Divine Liturgy is at 9:00 a.m. On civic holidays, Divine Liturgy is at 9:00 a.m.
- The church opens 15 minutes before the start of Liturgy, so please do not arrive more than 15 minutes before the Liturgy is scheduled to begin.
- **MASKS - Children under the age of 8 are not required to wear a mask. Children aged 8 and over should wear a mask if they are able. All adults are required to wear a mask during the entire service.** Masks will not be provided so it is necessary to bring your own. Please put your mask on in your car or outside. If you are not able to wear a mask then we ask that you do not attend Liturgy.
- Those who are medically vulnerable and at high risk should consider not attending Divine Liturgy at this time. Liturgies on Sundays and major feast days will continue to be posted on YouTube. The obligation to attend Liturgy on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is still dispensed by Bishop Bryan.
- Liturgy books are available at the back of the church to borrow and take home or return after.
- Please sit only at the places with a cross made out of tape on the pew backrest. Sit together with members of your own household only.
- Please do not move around the church. Remain at your seat for the entire service except if you have to use the washroom.
- Instructions will be given as to how to receive Eucharist during the liturgy. Eucharist is given as a dry host only. Eucharist will be given at the end of Liturgy. Please practice physical distancing in the communion line.
- At the end of Liturgy, please lower the kneeler, because this helps to indicate where sanitization is required after the Liturgy.

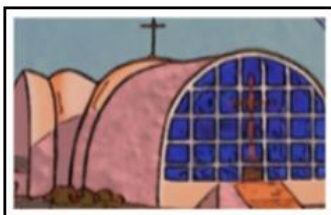
- **Solemn Communion** - Catechism program for children grade 2 and up who wish to receive the sacraments of Solemn Communion and Reconciliation

SCAM ALERT - Please be aware that fraudulent messages continue to circulate via e-mail, as well as via text and messaging apps, allegedly coming from our priests, bishop, or others in the Catholic community, asking for money, gift cards, or other gifts. **Please DISREGARD all such messages!** Do NOT reply or engage with the individuals sending these messages. The email addresses typically look like they could be real. The

message asks if you are busy, ask for a favour, or directly ask for iTunes or other gift cards or funds. **Do NOT send gift cards, money, or cash transfers if requested to do so over e-mail or via text message.** This applies to any such messages that people receive, not just clergy or from clergy! It could look like it is coming from friends or relatives, however the email will always be just a little different than what the real one is, or the name might be just a bit different as well. **Check the email address that the message is coming from** – our clergy email addresses are on our Eparchial website under the Eparchy Tab – Clergy & Religious! For example, if you received an email from bishop.bryanbayda.skeparchy@gmail.com do not respond to it! **Just block the sender and delete the email! Under no circumstance should you go and purchase gift cards or send any money, etc!** Therefore, if you receive messages asking for help like this from our bishops or priests, either contact their offices directly to check whether they are authentic, or just ignore. **If you are the victim of fraud, contact your local police or RCMP office.**
