INSTRUCTIONS FOR ATTENDING DIVINE LITURGY

AT SAINTS PETER & PAUL (Updated Nov. 6, 2020)

- **Sunday Liturgies** are at the following times: Saturday 5:00 p.m., Sunday 9:00 a.m. (Ukrainian) & Sunday 11:00 a.m. Those wishing to attend Divine Liturgy on Saturday evenings and Sunday mornings must make a reservation and receive confirmation to attend. To do this contact the parish office either by phone (306-343-6516) during office hours or email (sspp@sasktel.net) by Friday at 4:00 p.m. No walk-ins are allowed.
- **MASKS** - Our mask policy has been slightly expanded due to the new provincial regulations effective November 6, 2020. Now, only children under the age of 2 are NOT required to wear a mask. All other children and all adults are required to wear a mask during the entire service. Masks will not be provided so, it is necessary to bring your own. Please put your mask on in your car or outside. If you are not able to wear a mask then we ask that you do not attend Liturgy.
- **You do not need to pre-register for Liturgies on Feast Days, weekdays, Saturday mornings, or civic holidays.** Please register at the door when you get to church for any of these Liturgies. This is necessary in case contact tracing is required.
- **On major feast days, we have Liturgies at 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.** Liturgies are at 8:00 a.m. from Monday to Friday. Saturday morning Divine Liturgy is at 9:00 a.m. On civic holidays, Divine Liturgy is at 9:00 a.m.
- **The church opens 15 minutes before the start of Liturgy**, so please do not arrive more than 15 minutes before the Liturgy is scheduled to begin. *Now that we have colder temperatures, an orange pylon will be placed outside one of the doors to let everyone know the door is open.*
- **Those who are medically vulnerable and at high risk should consider not attending Divine Liturgy at this time.** Liturgies for Sundays and major feast days will continue to be posted on YouTube. The obligation to attend Liturgy on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is still dispensed by Bishop Bryan.
- Liturgy books are available at the back of the church to borrow and take home or return after.
- **Please sit only at the places with a cross made out of tape on the pew backrest.** Sit together with members of your own household only.
- **Please do not move around the church.** Remain at your seat for the entire service except if you have to use the washroom.
- Eucharist is given in the hand with a dry host only. Eucharist will be given at the end of Liturgy. Please practice physical distancing in the communion line.
- **At the end of Liturgy, please lower the kneeler**, because this helps to indicate where sanitization is required after the Liturgy.
- Thank you for your anticipated cooperation.

CONFESSIONS



The Fathers have resumed confessions during Sunday Liturgies. Confessions will be held in the church hall and will follow COVID-19 protocols and restrictions.

Confessions will be scheduled as follows:

Saturday 5:00 p.m. – Confessions begin at the **start** of Liturgy until no one is in line.

Sunday 9:00 a.m. – Confessions begin **after** the sermon until no one is in line.

Sunday 11:00 a.m. – Confessions begin at the **start** of Liturgy until no one is in line.

We ask that you line up by the confessionals. When the first person is finished and returns to the church, they should let the next person know that they can go down to the hall.

Each sign is \$25, and is made out of double-sided corrugated plastic 18"X 24" with a metal stand included.

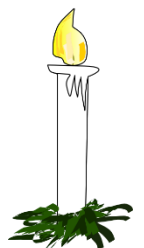
The signs are available to anyone from our parish, anyone of your families, neighbors etc.

First Week of Pylipiwka - (Philippian Fast, Philip's Fast)

In the first week of our journey, we prepare our hearts to receive the great mystery, the gift of God's son, the Light of the world, who is coming to us in the fast approaching time of Christmas.

This week, we commemorate the Feast of the Entrance of Mary in the Temple. The feast is on November 21st, but we continue in the Post-Festive season for 5 days after the Feast Day. This feast marks the first liturgical announcement of the birth of Christ during the Matins service: Christ is Born! Glorify Him! Christ comes from heaven! Let us go and meet Him! Christ is on earth! May He be exalted!

Mary goes into the Temple to prepare her heart for God. She is in the Temple where the Son of God will make His home until His birth. She is the servant of the Lord, who offers her life to God and to us by giving us a Saviour.

Let us praise the glorious entrance of the Mother of God:

Most holy Theotokos, honoured far above the heavens, you are both temple and palace. You are dedicated in the Temple of God to be prepared as a divine dwelling place for His coming.

Pray for us, that we may become worthy temples and dwelling places for Your Son and our Saviour and God. Help us to use our gifts and talents for God's glory and the good of others.

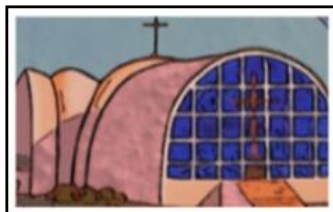
