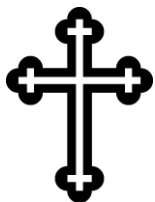

DURING COVID-19 (Updated June 4, 2021)

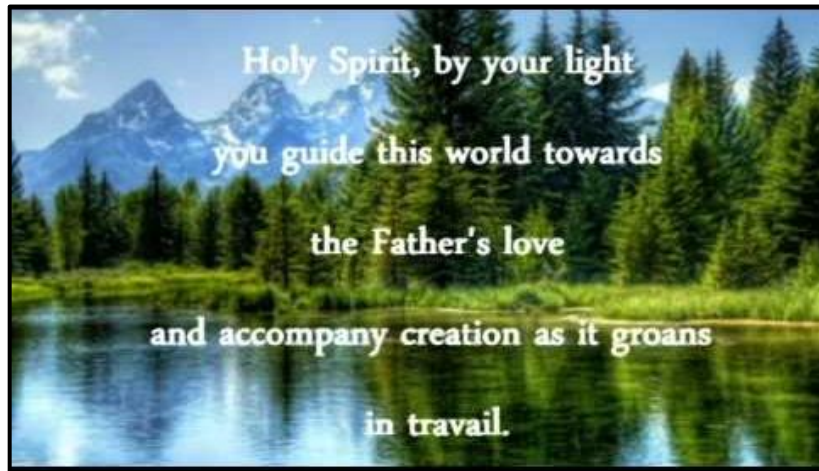
(ALL NEW INFORMATION IS IN BOLD TYPE)

- **EFFECTIVE May 30, 2021, THE ATTENDANCE LIMIT AT EACH SERVICE AT SAINTS PETER AND PAUL IS 150 PEOPLE ACCORDING TO NEW PROVINCIAL REGULATIONS.**
- Those wishing to attend Divine Liturgy on Saturday evenings and Sunday mornings must pre-register with the parish office. To make a reservation, please contact the parish office either by email (sspp@sasktel.net) by Friday at 4:00pm or by phone (306-343-6516) during office hours. No walk-ins are allowed.
- Sit together with members of your household only. Please sit only at the places with a cross made out of tape on the pew backrest.
- **MASKS** – All children age 2 and older and all adults are required to wear a mask during the entire service even if you are vaccinated. Masks will not be provided so it is necessary to bring your own. Please put your mask on in your car or outside. If you are not able to wear a mask then we ask that you do not attend Liturgy.
- **The church opens 30 minutes before the start of Liturgy.** An orange pylon is placed outside one of the doors to let everyone know when the doors are open.
- At a Liturgy without preregistration, please sign in with the usher at the door when you get to church. This is necessary in case contact tracing is required.
- Divine Liturgy books are available at the back of the church to borrow and take home or return after.
- Please do not move around the church. Remain at your seat for the entire service except if you have to use the washroom. Please enter and exit the pew from the same aisle (i.e., do not walk across the empty pews).
- At the end of Liturgy, please lower the kneeler, because this helps to indicate where sanitization is required after the Liturgy.
- Eucharist is given in the hand with a dry host only. Eucharist will be given at the end of Liturgy. Please practice physical distancing in the communion line.
- Those who are medically vulnerable and at high risk should consider not attending Divine Liturgy at this time. Liturgies on Sundays and major feast days will continue to be posted on YouTube. The obligation to attend Liturgy on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is still dispensed by Bishop Bryan.
- Thank you for your anticipated cooperation.

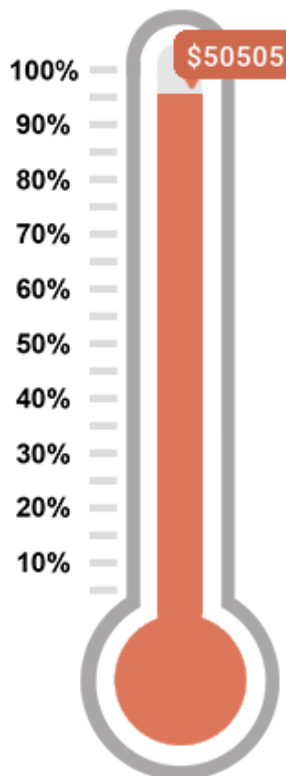

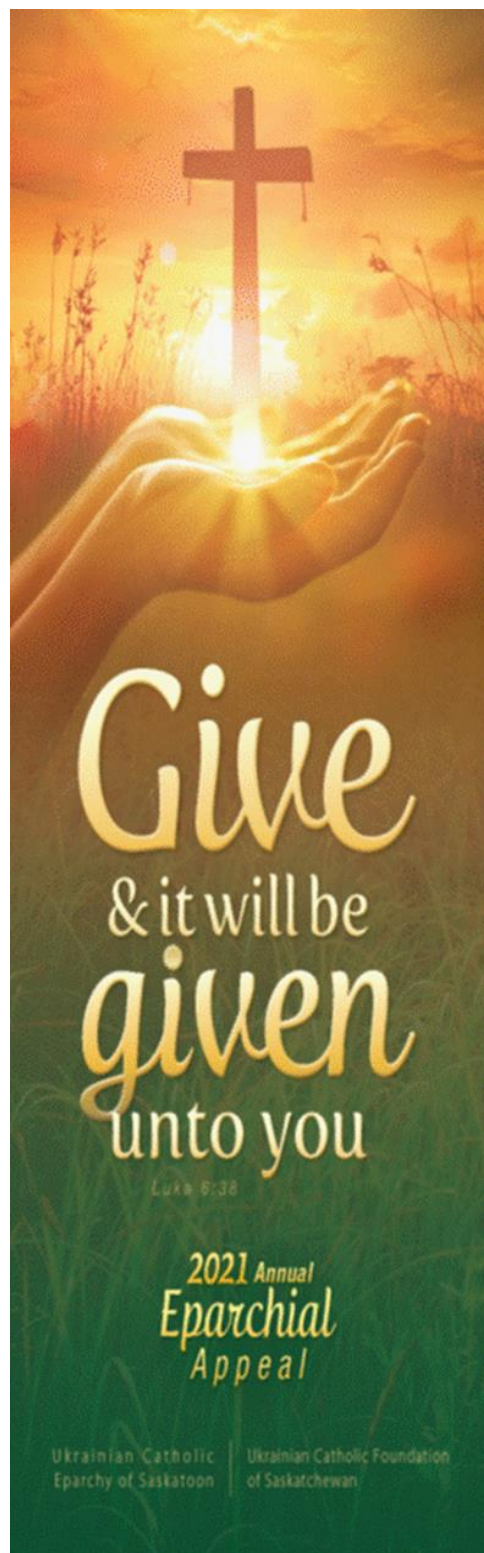
\$50,505 raised from **177** families equals **98%** of our 2021 Goal of **\$52,000** at Saints Peter & Paul.

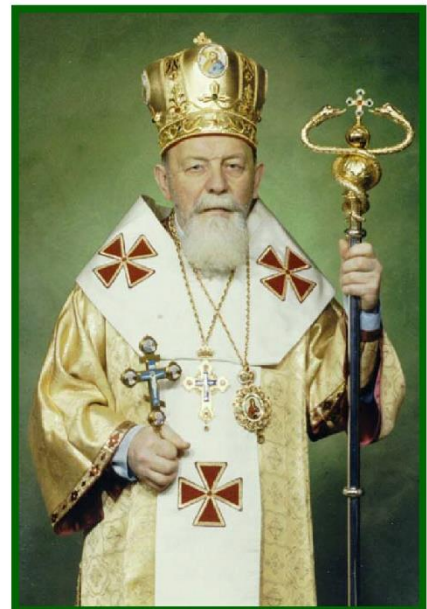

Pope Francis appoints Archbishop Jurkovič New Nuncio to Canada



His Excellency Archbishop Ivan Jurkovič was born on June 10, 1952, in Banja Loka, Kočevje, Slovenia.

On June 29, 1977, he was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Ljubljana (Slovenia). He is a graduate from the Faculty of Theology in Ljubljana. Between 1980 and 1984 he completed his studies in Canon Law at the Pontifical Lateran University in Rome and at the Pontifical Ecclesiastical Academy. He holds a Doctorate in Canon Law.

On May 1, 1984, he joined the diplomatic service of the Holy See serving in the following capacities and locations:

- 1984-1988 Secretary of the Apostolic Nunciature to Korea;
- 1988-1992 Counsellor of the Apostolic Nunciature to Colombia;
- 1992-1995 Counsellor of the Representation of the Holy See to the Russian Federation;
- 1996-2001 Counsellor at the Section for Relations with States of the Secretariat of State of the Holy See in Vatican City.

On October 6, 2001, Msgr. Jurkovič received Episcopal Consecration and was appointed Titular Archbishop of Corbavia. Following the same, he served in the following missions:

- 2001-2004 Apostolic Nuncio to Belarus (appointed July 27, 2001);
- 2004-2011 Apostolic Nuncio to Ukraine (appointed April 22, 2004);
- 2011-2016 Apostolic Nuncio to the Russian Federation (appointed February 2011). At same time, Apostolic Nuncio in Uzbekistan (appointed July 22, 2011);
- 2016-2021 Permanent Observer of the Holy See to the Office of the United Nations and Other International Organizations in Geneva, Permanent Observer to the World Trade Organization (WTO), and also Representative of the Holy See to the International Organization for Migration (IOM) (appointed February 13, 2016).

The Holy Father appointed Archbishop Jurkovič Apostolic Nuncio to Canada on June 5, 2021.

Archbishop Jurkovič's mother tongue is Slovenian, however, he is likewise well versed in Italian, Spanish, English, Russian, German, French, Serbian, Croatian and Ukrainian.

The Redemptorists are also set up for e-transfers. Use “Ukrainian Catholic Mission” as the recipient and the email address, ucmsaskatoon@gmail.com. The Redemptorists are set up for auto-deposit so no secret questions and answers are required even though you may be asked to set that up. This method can be used for Christmas or Easter gifts to the clergy and bishop as well as Sorokousty offerings. The Redemptorists do NOT accept e-transfers for Liturgy stipends.
