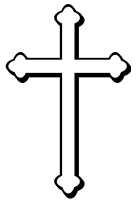

The First Sunday of the Great Fast is called the **Sunday of Orthodoxy**. It is the day we celebrate the return of icons to the churches. In the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> centuries the church was persecuted for its use of icons in the church. At the Seventh Ecumenical Council it was decided to allow icons for use in churches and for private devotions.

In celebration of this great event we are having a procession with icons at the beginning of the **11 a.m. Divine Liturgy on Sunday, March 6<sup>th</sup>: the First Sunday of the Great Fast**. All children, youth, and adults who wish to be part of the procession are asked to bring an icon and a stand from home to carry into the church for the procession. 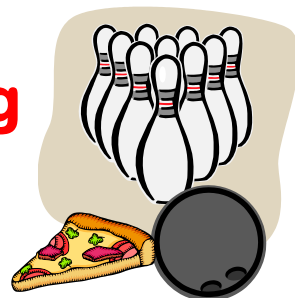

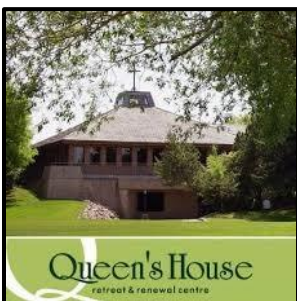
