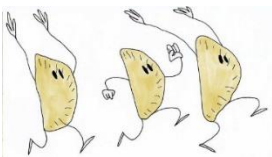

## Pro-life Personal Prayer Intentions to Pentecost 2022

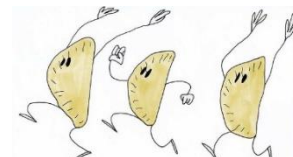


**May 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Easter, Myrrh-Bearing Women**
