The contribution baskets remain at the front of the church on the small tables.

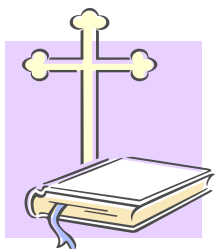
Hand sanitizer is available at the entrance of the church.
