#### Job Summary:

The Children's Program Coordinator (CPC) is the key person responsible for ensuring the effective and consistent delivery of religious programming for the children and youth of Saints Peter & Paul. The coordinator's responsibilities comprise duties related to recruitment and coordination of volunteers, preparation and organization of program documentation and materials, program registration, program development and support, program facilitation, and scheduling and program coordination in conjunction with Pastor and administrative and volunteer personnel as well as outside agencies such as schools, eparchy, etc.

Children's programming includes Sunday School, Solemn Communion, Altar Services and Children of Mary, Junior Ukrainian Catholic Youth, Junior Choir, St. Nicholas Sunday, Living Gospel, and Vacation Bible School. These programs may be suspended and/or added to from time to time based on needs of the Parish and its membership.

- Demonstrated ability to work successfully with volunteers
- Enjoys working with children / youth
- Above average organizational skills


