### DISTRIBUTION OF THE HOLY EUCHARIST:

Holy Communion is now being distributed under both species (consecrated bread and wine) on individual spoons.

*\*Revoking the letter of March 13, 2020, on-line participation in Divine Liturgy is no longer considered a fulfillment of one's obligation for Sundays and Feasts, with the exception of those in poor health, who would be unable to attend church in normal circumstances.*

### Job Summary:

The Children's Program Coordinator (CPC) is the key person responsible for ensuring the effective and consistent delivery of religious programming for the children and youth of Saints Peter & Paul. The coordinator's responsibilities comprise duties related to recruitment and coordination of volunteers, preparation and organization of program documentation and materials, program registration, program development and support, program facilitation, and scheduling and program coordination in conjunction with Pastor and administrative and volunteer personnel as well as outside agencies such as schools, eparchy, etc.

Children's programming includes Sunday School, Solemn Communion, Altar Services and Children of Mary, Junior Ukrainian Catholic Youth, Junior Choir, St. Nicholas Sunday, Living Gospel, and Vacation Bible School. These programs may be suspended and/or added to from time to time based on needs of the Parish and its membership.

This is a project set up by Streams of Hope. They have acquired a 40-foot container can which fits up to 20,000 kg of aid. This container will be at the warehouse on 3403 Faithful Avenue. It will be available from June 17 to July 16. It will be open Friday from 5-9 pm and Saturday and Sunday from 11-5 pm. The container will be shipped to Chernivtsi to Marta Levchenko, a trusted contact. The items they are looking to collect include: Work gloves, nonperishable foods, cooking oil, diapers and baby food, feminine and personal hygiene products, medical supplies for kids and grown-ups, wheelchairs and walkers, crutches, assistance items for adults and kids with disabilities, strollers for babies and toddlers, and pet food. 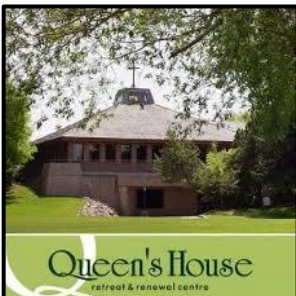
## Dormition Ukrainian Catholic Parish - Engagement Coordinator
