





Origins of Bishop Roborecki Branch UCBC

A Saskatoon branch of the Ukrainian Catholic Brotherhood of Canada was organized at St. George's Cathedral soon after the December, 1932 Convention. The Saskatoon branch formally came into existence on May 14, 1933 and was granted the #4. It was initially called *Ukrainian Catholic Brotherhood of Canada, #4* but quickly became known as *Ukrainian Catholic Brotherhood of Canada, Saskatoon Branch.*

Some time after the death of His Excellency, Andrew Roborecki, Saskatchewan's first Ukrainian Catholic eparch (bishop) on October 23, 1982, the branch was renamed *Ukrainian Catholic Brotherhood of Canada, Bishop Roborecki Branch #304* in his honor. The first mention of the new name appears in the 1988 Minutes. Today, the branch is known as the *Ukrainian Catholic Brotherhood of Canada, Bishop Roborecki Branch*.

Members of other Ukrainian Catholic parishes in Saskatoon and area are eligible and, in fact, are members of Bishop Roborecki Branch. Bishop Roborecki Branch is the only UCBC branch in Saskatoon.
