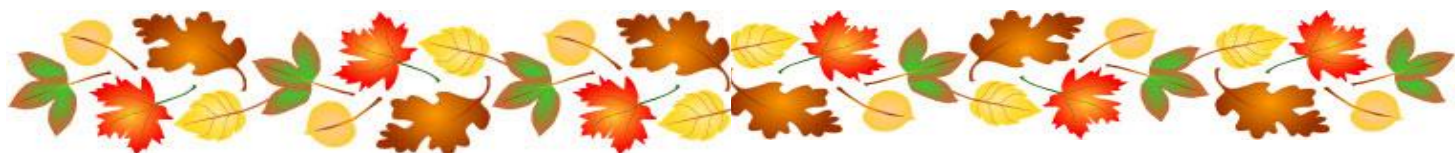

We will collect donations of brand-NEW socks, toques & mittens from **October 8 – November 4, 2022.**

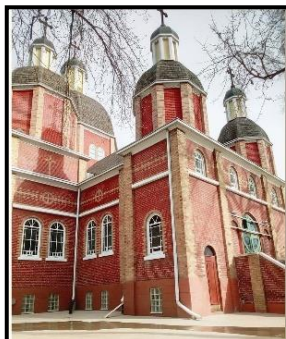

- Womenswear sizes 16 and up



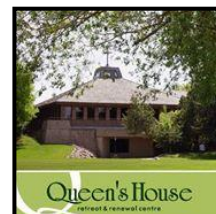
