HOSPITAL VISITATION



BABA'S CLOSET



Baba's Closet is not a store where you can buy things, but rather a shop where newly-arrived Ukrainians — families or individuals — displaced by the ongoing war in their country, can pick up free items that help them start a new life in Saskatoon.

Baba's Closet coordinator, Nettie Cherniatenski, started accepting and organizing donations in her garage just days after the war broke out in Ukraine. After just two weeks, it became evident that a bigger space was

needed since so many people were eager to contribute. She then sent emails to storage and warehouse owners inquiring if there was a place available for the donations. After a couple of false starts, she was blessed to cross paths with a person who offered her a space on 51st street and who paid the lease for one year! Nettie, known around her community as Baba Nettie, calls this person an angel. It was during this search for a larger space, that someone pointed out that she needed to give this new location a name. Since she was already known as Baba Nettie, the name Baba's Closet was appropriate.

Newly arrived Ukrainians can find all sorts of essentials -toiletries, towels, bedding, clothing, food items, kitchen items, and dishware, and even some surprising items such as sewing machines and musical instruments. No matter what the needs are, all visitors receive a very warm welcome.

Baba's Closet is a volunteer driven initiative, supported by the Ukrainian Orthodox Parish of All Saints and recognized by the Ukrainian Canadian Congress Saskatoon branch as a necessary resource for the newly arrived Ukrainian refugees. The need for donations is ongoing. Items that are required are updated on Facebook. Any monetary donations over \$25 will receive a tax receipt from All Saints Parish. The store is open Tuesday thru Saturday 1-5 pm at which time volunteers will happily accept your donations.

We will continue to provide weekly updates in our parish bulletin and on our parish Facebook page of the items that are needed at Baba's Closet. Currently NO donations are being accepted as they are full. Also, Baba's Closet will be closed on Saturday, October 22 to Tuesday, October 25.
