

After taking a long break because of COVID-19, hospital visitations by the Redemptorists to Royal University Hospital have resumed. Fr. Michael usually visits





We have partnered with the Saskatoon Friendship Inn's Compassion Project, as well as St. Goretti Community School to provide those communities with warm winter accessories.


