Conscience Rights Petition

'Conscience rights' are what **allow health professionals to refuse to provide treatment that goes against their morals or religion**. In the past this has mostly meant abortion. But recently it's been applied to medically assisted death as well.

Please note:

- Coercion, intimidation or other forms of pressure intended to force physicians and healthcare workers and health institutions to become parties in medical assistance in dying (MAiD) directly or through effective referral is a violation of fundamental freedoms of conscience.
- Conscience protection for medical professionals is necessary for patients to know they are receiving the best care possible.
- While provincial governments and medical associations were obligated to implement MAiD following its de-as done) to protect the conscience rights of medical professionals who refuse to participate in MAiD as well as to prevent professional regulatory bodies from requiring their members to participate in MAiD.



Therefore: we are asking the people of Saskatchewan to sign a petition that requests the assembly of Saskatchewan to pass legislation that will protect the conscience rights of physicians and health care workers against coercion, intimidation or other forms of pressure intended to force physicians and healthcare workers and health institutions to become parties in medical assistance in dying directly or indirectly.

Please prayerfully think about this important issue. You will have an opportunity to sign the petition in church. Alternately, the petition can be accessed online [here](#).
