





Christmas Pastoral Letter of His Beatitude Sviatoslav



The Nativity Scene

On Christmas Eve we receive and celebrate the greatest gift God could give us, the birth of His Son, Jesus. In the Ukrainian tradition we say, "Христос Раждається!" This means "Christ is Born!" We are reminded that He is continually being born within us, and both His birth into an earthly life and His resurrection into a spiritual life are far better than anything else on this earth. Our reply to the greeting is, "Славіте Його!" which means, "Glorify Him!"

In front of the Icon of the Nativity of our Lord and Savior here in church, there are symbols. Each symbol has a special significance.

THE STAR: The three Wise Men followed a star to the place where Jesus was born. The first star in the sky on Christmas Eve is the sign telling us to begin celebrating.

HAY: There was hay in the manger where Jesus was laid. We put hay on and under the supper table.

A TABLECLOTH: The white tablecloth is spread over the hay. Mary wrapped Jesus in swaddling clothes and put Him in the manger.

SHEAF OF WHEAT: The sheaf of wheat is called a "Дідух" (Didukh) which means "forefather". On Christmas Eve we think of our departed relatives. We invite them to join us in the celebration.

THE "КОЛАЧ" (KOLACH): Jesus said He was the bread of Life come from heaven. Jesus gives Himself to us in the form of bread at Holy Communion.

THE CANDLE: Jesus also said He was the light of the world. He is the light that shows us the way to our heavenly Father.

THE CAROLS: The carols are represented by the carol booklet which brings to mind the angels who sang praises to God when Jesus was born. We, too, greet the Savior by singing the first carol on Christmas Eve.

THE BOWL: The bowl represents the twelve meatless dishes served at the Christmas Eve supper which reminds us of Jesus' twelve apostles eating the Last Supper with Him.

THE ICON: The icon which includes Mary with the Christ Child tells us what happened that first Christmas – God became man. He was born of a Virgin.

THE EMBROIDERED CLOTH: The embroidered cloth is called a "Рушник" (Rushnyk). We honour and protect the icon with the "Рушник".

The Nativity Scene reminds us of the great mystery which took place on Christmas night long ago. Mary gave birth to Jesus. Jesus, the Son of God, came to live among mankind. He is also called EMMANUEL, a name which means GOD WITH US! "З нами Бог!" (Z'nameh Boh!) It is a suitable name because Jesus made it happen for God to be with us all the time.

At Christmas time, we express our hope, and our trust, and our joy through the ancient song from the prophet Isaiah:



"God is with us!
Understand this, all you nations
and be humbled, for God is with us!"
