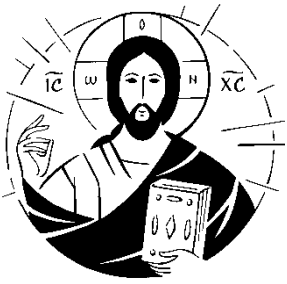

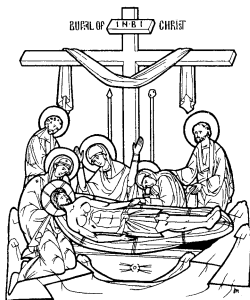

### Weekend Divine Liturgies on February 25 & 26



The First Sunday of the Great Fast is called the **Sunday of Orthodoxy**. It is the day we celebrate the return of icons to the churches. In the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> centuries the church was persecuted for its use of icons in the church. At the Seventh Ecumenical Council it was decided to allow icons for use in churches and for private devotions.

In celebration of this great event we are having a procession with icons at the beginning of **each Divine Liturgy: the First Sunday of the Great Fast**. All **children, youth, and adults** who wish to be part of the procession are asked to bring an icon and a stand from home to carry into the church for the procession. 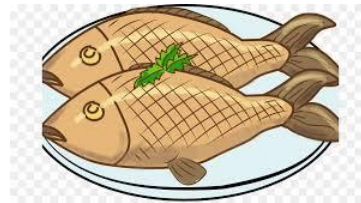

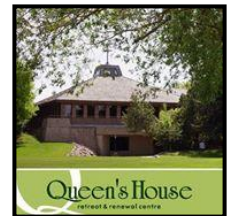

**The UGCC declares a church-wide Day of fasting, prayer and almsgiving**

A day of fasting, prayer and almsgiving will be held in all Eparchies and Exarchates of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church throughout the world on February 24, 2023. Such an initiative was announced by His Beatitude Sviatoslav, Father and Head of the UGCC, on behalf of the Synod of Bishops.

On February 24, a year will pass since the beginning of the full-scale war that Russia unleashed against Ukraine. According to the decision of the Bishops of the UGCC, the whole Church will spend this day in fasting, prayer and doing works of mercy.

On this day at 12:00 p.m. Kyiv time, a 12-hour prayer marathon will begin on "Live TV" (Zhyve Telebachennia), which will unite in prayer all the faithful on all continents. There are no separate prescriptions for fasting - it is about restrictions and self-discipline according to the capabilities of each believer.

"May this day be an opportunity for us to do good to someone: comfort the sad, clothe the naked, warm the frozen, feed the hungry," explained His Beatitude Sviatoslav, speaking about the need not only to fast and pray, but also to do charity.

"On this day, let us sacrifice our spiritual efforts and our prayers for the victory of the Ukrainian people in this unequal battle, as well as for our army," urged the Head of the UGCC.

Knights of Columbus was founded by Fr. Michael McGivney on March 29, 1882. This year, 2023, marks the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the establishment of the Knights of Columbus in Saskatchewan. Knights of Columbus world-wide spend countless charitable hours helping many organizations, and individuals, young and elderly. The Knights continue to do their part to spread the faith and love as we serve so many in Christ's name.

Many councils have members starting at the age of eighteen. Some members have made commitments that are life time goals, like helping others. Like any organization, the councils' have budgets and goals and continue to operate on the founding principles of fraternity. Whether it be small or big, we try our best to do what we can. Some councils have many members that spend a lot of time with bigger organizations that build and help in so many ways. Just to name one of the big projects right here in Saskatoon is the expansion of the existing Columbian Manor to include a new senior's complex with everything from affordable seniors housing to assisted living and a chapel for prayer. Take a short drive on Louise Street just south of what most of us know as the Villa. This is a multi million-dollar project that will house so many.

Our council #11775 is small but with big hearts and we strive to provide in anyway we can. It's the little things that eventually become even bigger. Thus, the little things we fund raise for contribute to many bigger things in the road ahead. For example, since our council's inauguration on April 1, 1996, over \$116,000 has been provided to the needs of the parish. This represents 32% of our fundraising work. About 12% of the fundraising provides support to the youth camps, vocations to the priesthood, and scholarships to children/grandchildren of members. You will find several of our members working behind the scenes from setting up the outdoor manger creche, helping with perogy and cabbage roll bees, ushering in church, communion servers etc.

We will continue to do for our parish, our families and our neighbours.
