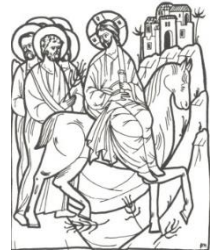

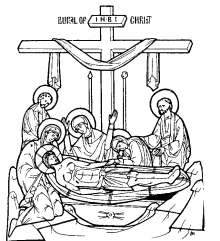

Most Reverend Andriy Rabiw

Auxiliary Bishop Andriy Rabiw was born October 1, 1975 in Lviv, Ukraine. He pursued seminary studies at St. Josaphat Ukrainian Catholic Seminary in Washington, D.C., and was ordained a priest in December of 2001 by Archbishop Stefan Soroka at the Ukrainian Catholic Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Philadelphia.

Bishop Rabiw holds a bachelor's degree in philosophy (1999) and a licentiate in Canon Law (2008) from the Catholic University of America; and a Master of Divinity degree (2002), from the Dominican House of Studies in Washington, D.C.

After ordination, Bishop Rabiw held pastoral assignments at various parishes and chanceries in the United States. On August 8, 2017, His Holiness Pope Francis named him as Auxiliary Bishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Philadelphia. His episcopal ordination took place on September 3, 2017 in Saint George's Cathedral in Lviv where in his youth he had served as an altar boy.

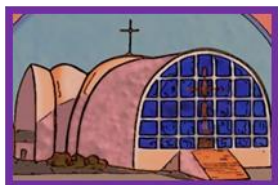
On November 10, 2022, His Holiness Pope Francis appointed the Most Reverend Andriy Rabiw as Auxiliary Bishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Winnipeg.

Ukrainian Catholic Foundation of Saskatchewan (UCFSask) is considering applications for grants from the Grant Fund Program. The Foundation is looking for applications from Parishes/Missions and approved Eparchial Organizations for projects/initiatives that align with the Foundation's mission and purpose. In addition, grant allocations will also be guided by the recommendations for action from the Eparchial 2014 SOBOR Document – The Vibrant Parish. The Foundation will be looking to distribute up to \$50,000 from the Grant Fund this year.
