# **Most Reverend Andriy Rabiy**

Auxiliary Bishop Andriy Rabiy was born October 1, 1975 in Lviv, Ukraine. He pursued seminary studies at St. Josaphat Ukrainian Catholic Seminary in Washington, D.C., and was ordained a priest in December of 2001 by Archbishop Stefan Soroka at the Ukrainian Catholic Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Philadelphia.

Bishop Rabiy holds a bachelor's degree in philosophy (1999) and a licentiate in Canon Law (2008) from the Catholic University of America; and a Master of Divinity degree (2002), from the Dominican House of Studies in Washington, D.C.

After ordination, Bishop Rabiy held pastoral assignments at various parishes and chanceries in the United States. On August 8, 2017, His Holiness Pope Francis named him as Auxiliary Bishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Philadelphia. His episcopal ordination took place on September 3, 2017 in Saint George's Cathedral in Lviv where in his youth he had served as an altar boy.

On November 10, 2022, His Holiness Pope Francis appointed the Most Reverend Andriy Rabiy as Auxiliary Bishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Winnipeg.
