





## **NOTICE!** Road and Sidewalk Closures

Road and Sidewalk Closures will begin **Avenue M. South, Saskatoon, in front of St. George Cathedral and Rectory Office**, starting **April 25, 2023**, for work on the Cathedral stairs project, and until project completion. Closures will begin by 8:30 am.
