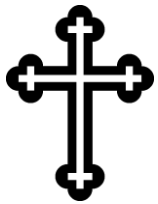
SOROKOUSTY SERVICES – PRAYERS FOR THE DECEASED †

and place it in the collection basket or drop it off at the office.

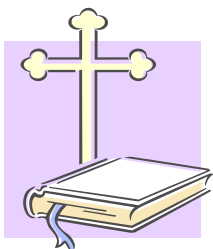

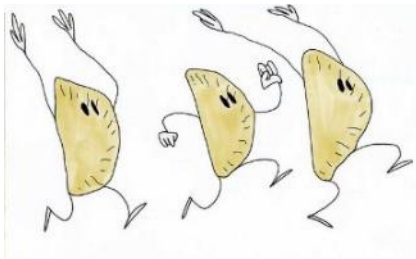

UCWLC National Scholarships 2023

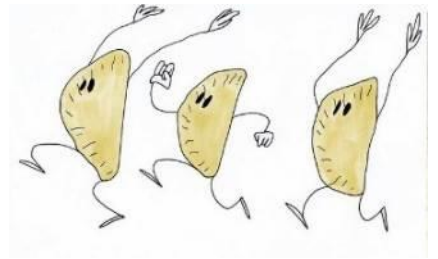

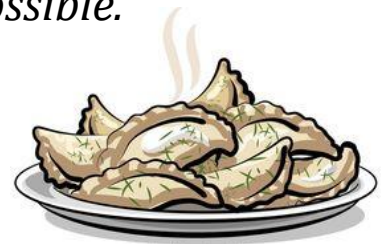

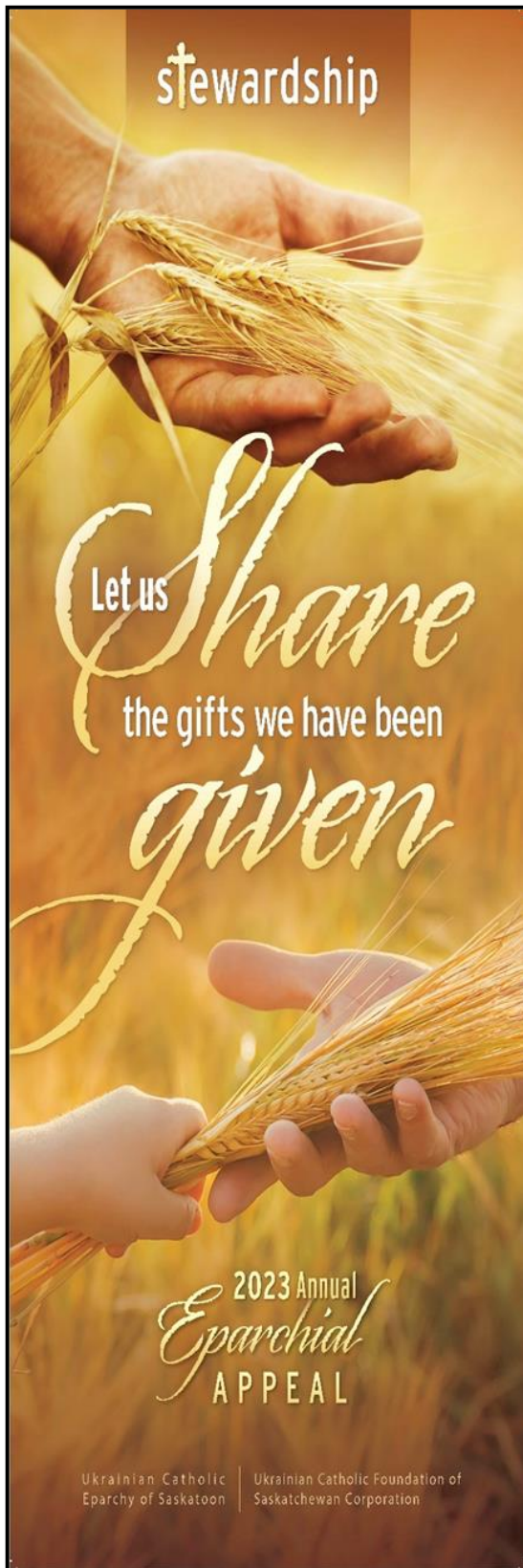
I have complete confidence that you will carry out your responsibilities in a manner that will benefit the Eparchy as an institution and the faithful of our church.

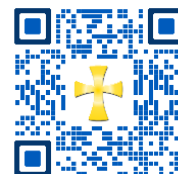

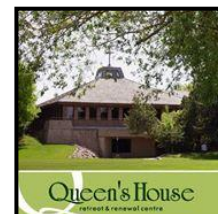
