

and place it in the collection basket or drop it off at the office.







Over the past number of years, the Eparchy's sources of revenues have either decreased or have been eliminated. The amount of Cathedral revenue, which is based on Sunday collections at Parish churches, has decreased because membership in our Eparchy has been steadily decreasing over the years which has resulted lower attendance at Sunday Liturgies. In addition, post-COVID attendance has not come back to the pre-COVID levels. The grant funding that the Eparchy enjoyed in previous years from various organizations, like the Catholic Missions in Canada, have also been decreased. The Eparchy has been served notice that future grant funds may not even be available. Therefore, the Eparchy must now seek other sources of revenue to ensure the continuation and sustainability of programs and services such as Covenant of Care, management of Eparchial archives, managing the inventory of sacred items and much more. Donations to the Annual Eparchial Appeal is one way the Faithful of the Eparchy can help.

In Matthew 25:14-30, Jesus told His listeners a parable about a wealthy man who left three servants in charge of substantial sums of money. To each one, he gave the instruction, "Put this money to work until I come back". This important parable illustrates the value God places on stewarding properly and faithfully the resources that He gives those who trust in Him. 
