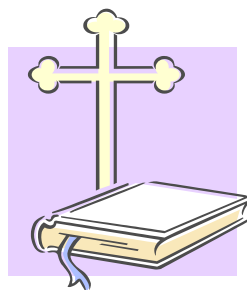

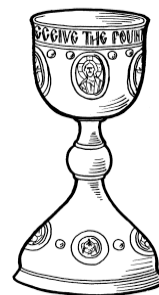

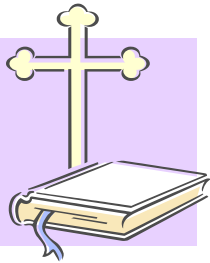

- Members without email will be contacted by our Phoning Committee.

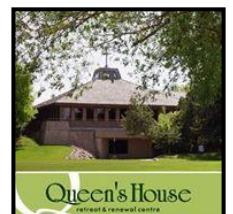
