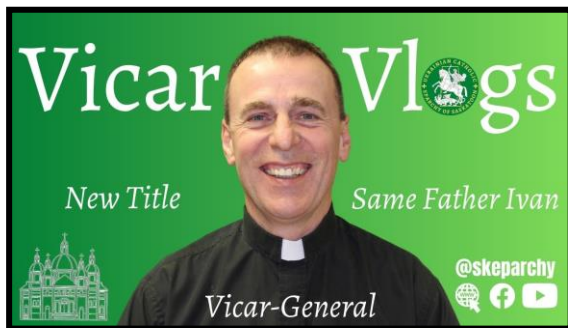




UCWLC National Scholarships 2023
