

#### **KEEP LIFE SACRED!**



The Season of Creation is an annual celebration of prayer and action intended to increase awareness of God's love and protect God's creation. It is celebrated by Christians of all traditions, and the leaders of various churches have encouraged the faithful to participate. The season begins on September 1, the World Day of Prayer for Creation, and runs through October 4, the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, the patron saint of ecology in many Western traditions. September 1 was proclaimed World Day of Prayer for Creation, or Creation Day by Ecumenical Patriarch Dimitrios I from the Orthodox in 1989, and was embraced by the other major Christian European churches in 2001 and by Pope Francis for the Roman Catholic Church in 2015.

This year we shall celebrate the Season of Creation by listening to a six-part series of interviews with our very own and celebrated iconographer Mrs. Anna Mycyk. 
