


Education Committee Announcement

The Education Committee is excited to announce a very special DVD presentation entitled:

The Jewish Roots of the Eucharist – Unlocking the Mysteries of the Last Supper!

This will be held in our parish auditorium on November 26th after the Knights of Columbus breakfast at 1:00 p.m.

If you are like most of us, scripture, especially the Old Testament, requires some explanation to see how the Old is fulfilled in the New! In most cases it's all Greek to us!



Dr. Brant Pitre does an amazing job explaining:

- How it is that the 1st century Jews came to believe in Jesus, the Eucharist, and the Real Presence.
- How a Jew like Paul, or any of the apostles, go from believing that drinking any blood, much less human blood was an abomination before God, to believing that drinking the blood of Jesus was necessary for Christians.

Dr. Pitre is a distinguished research Professor of Scripture at The Augustine Institute, receiving a Ph.D. in New Testament and ancient Judaism from the University of Notre Dame, Indiana. He is the author of several **CD and DVD Bible Studies**, exploring the Jewish roots of Scripture and the Catholic Faith.
