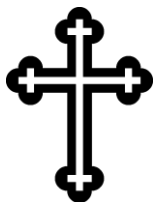

MARRIAGE PREPARATION 2024

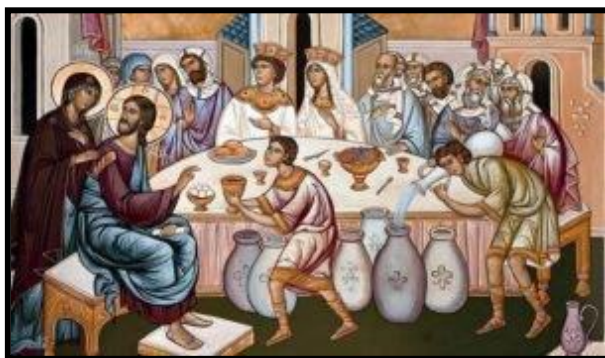
Getting Married? Congratulations!

We wish you every blessing. Here is how to begin your sacramental preparation...

All couples who are planning marriage over the next year should speak to their Parish Priest **as soon as possible**.

Couples are also encouraged to register for an approved Marriage Preparation Course such as the **Crown them With Honor and Glory Course** developed in the Eparchy of Saskatoon to prepare specifically for marriage in the Ukrainian Catholic Church.

Note: This program includes both self-study of the **Crown Them with Honor and Glory** Booklet, online Inventory with guided reflections (FOCCUS), and in-person or zoom class/retreat sessions. While the self-study and Inventory are independent couple work, the sessions require real time attendance online or in person at St. George's Cathedral if possible (special circumstances may be accommodated).
