UKRAINIAN CATHOLIC FOUNDATION OF SASKATCHEWAN GRANT FUND PROGRAM

Ukrainian Catholic Foundation of Saskatchewan (UCFSask) is considering applications for grants from the Grant Fund Program. The Foundation is looking for applications from Parishes/Missions and approved Eparchial Organizations for projects/initiatives that align with the Foundation's mission and purpose. While applications for all worthwhile projects/initiatives will be considered, for this year, preference will be given to those applications for projects/initiatives in support of ministries such as youth programs, social justice programs, initiatives designed to grow Parish membership and any projects/initiatives intended to make the Parish a "Vibrant Parish".

The Foundation will be looking to distribute up to **\$70,000** from the Grant Fund this year.

To receive this grant money, Parishes/Missions or Eparchial Organizations will be required to complete a grant application form. 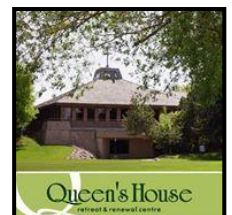

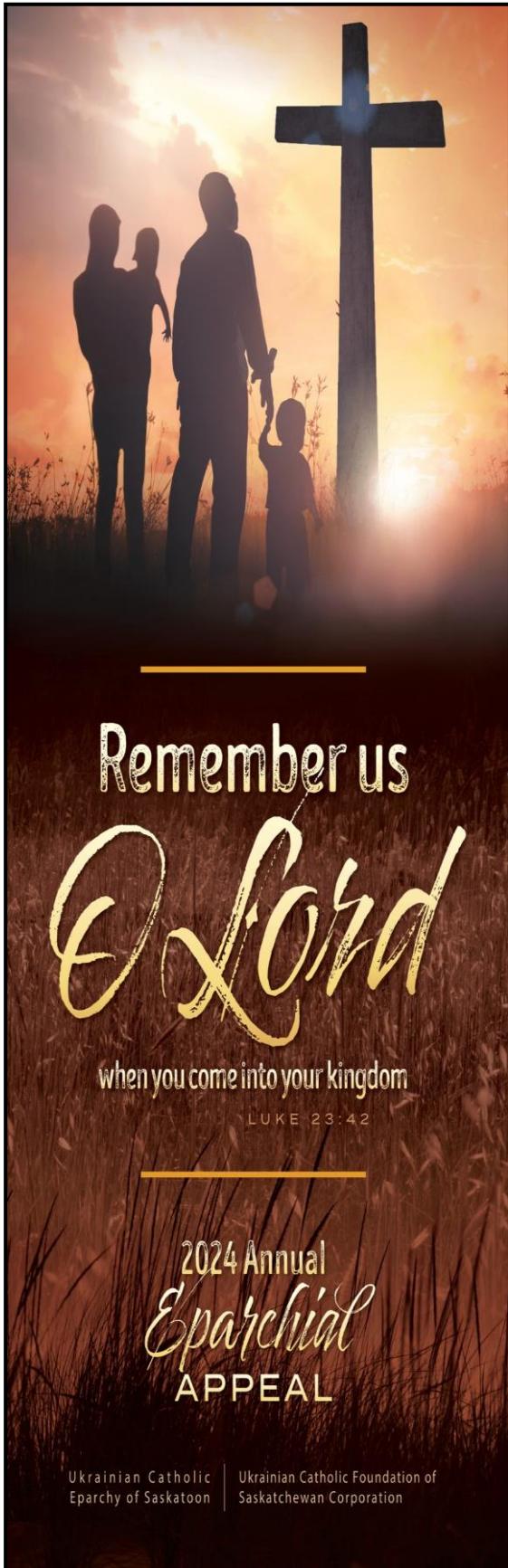
