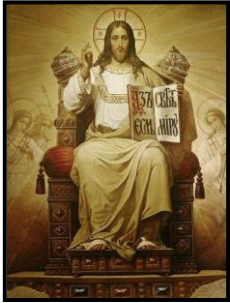

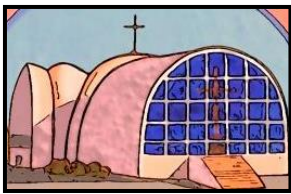

ATTENTION ALUMNI – St. Vladimir's College

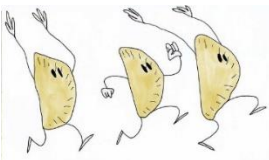
You are invited to a Reunion!

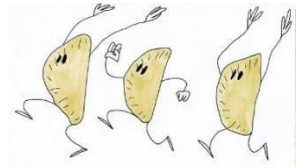

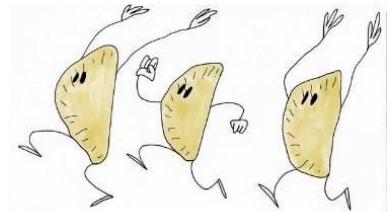
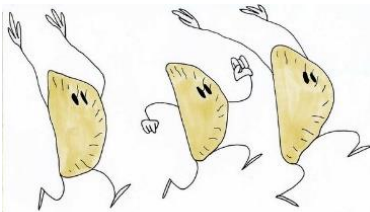
