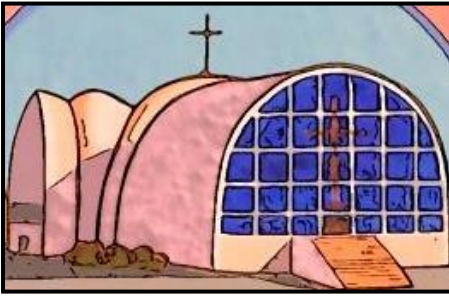
Thursday, May 16th - International Vyshyvanka Day

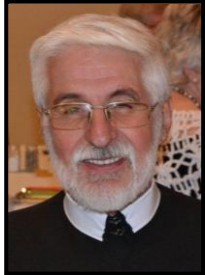

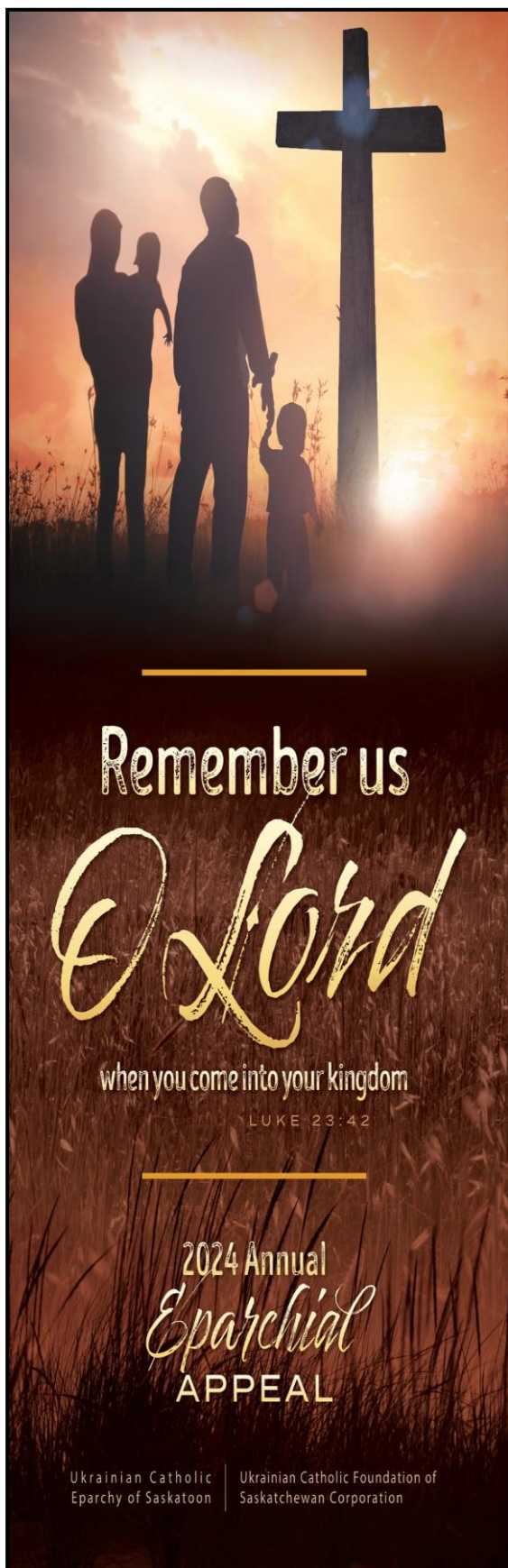

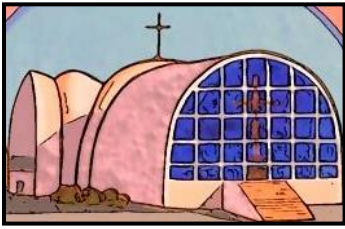
