# Message from the Service and Social Justice Committee

The Service and Social Justice Committee (SSJC) would like to empower and educate parishioners of the charities that we support, by profiling two charities per month. This month we profile The Welcome Home and Nashi.

The Welcome Home in Winnipeg, is a charity that receives annual donations from the Operating fund. Welcome Home first opened its doors in September 1993. It is a faith based community that serves as a "house church" to the people of North Point Douglas neighbourhood and beyond. The home is under the leadership of Fr. Larry Kondra, a Redemptorist and former pastor of St. Peter and Paul. The live-in community includes Redemptorists, and a group of dedicated lay people who run the home. The goal is to build relationships and partner with different organizations. Food hampers and lunch bags are provided once a week and there is support to those in need who knock at the door. Liturgies are offered Sunday mornings along with bi-weekly catechism classes. The home hosts many monthly events and programs. Donations or volunteering can be made by calling 1-204-946-5352.
